



Adjust the hook for alignment with tile then fix screw 2. Repeat and keep hook spacing 48" apart b. Rail installation 1. Mount the Rail by dropping in the Rail Clamp C 2. If needed, connect rails with Splice Bar by inserting into the slots S on the end of rail, then tighten all screws on splice bar 3. Tighten Screws 3 and 4 to fix Rail Clamp C 	Tor the application.
4. Set to the desired height and use level to confirm the rail at level position then tighten two standing screws 5 and 6.

Fix hook on the rafter with one 5/16 x 3-1/2 wood screws 1 (not provided). Adjust the flushing alignment with shingle then fix screw 2. Repeat and keep hook spacing 48" apart b. Rail installation 1. Mount the Rail by dropping in the Rail Clamp C 2. If needed, connect rails with Splice Bar by inserting into the slots S on the end of rail, then tighten all screws on splice bar 3. Tighten Screws 3 and 4 to fix Rail Clamp C 4. Set to the desired height and use level to confirm the rail at level position then tighten two standing screws 5 and 6. c. Micro-inverter or Optimizer Ready (optional) Use slot O in the middle of the Rail to fix Micro-inverter or
